SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1025

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "clams" delete the rest of the line and insert a period.
2	Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete <u>page 2</u> and insert:
3	"SECTION 1. (1) On or before December 31, 2021, the State Department of Fish and
4	Wildlife shall produce a survey of bay clam populations in priority areas in Tillamook Bay.
5	"(2) By rule, the department shall establish the priority areas identified in subsection (1)
6	of this section.
7	"SECTION 2. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall establish a Tillamook
8	Bay Clam Advisory Committee.
9	"(2) The department shall appoint to the committee a balance of persons who take bay
10	clams for commercial purposes, take bay clams for noncommercial purposes, are members
11	of a group that advocates conservation or have another interest in bay clams.
12	"(3) The committee shall make recommendations to the department on:
13	"(a) Adopting rules related to bay clams;
14	"(b) Ensuring the sustainability of the take of bay clams in Tillamook Bay;
15	"(c) Balancing the take of bay clams in Tillamook Bay for commercial purposes with the
16	take of bay clams in Tillamook Bay for noncommercial purposes;
17	"(d) Establishing physical boundaries for, or seasonal restrictions on, the take of bay
18	clams in Tillamook Bay for commercial purposes, to reduce conflicts between persons who
19	take bay clams in Tillamook Bay for commercial purposes and salmon anglers in and around
20	the Ghost Hole fishing area in Tillamook Bay;
21	"(e) Establishing areas in Tillamook Bay that are closed to the take of bay clams for
22	commercial purposes and open to the take of bay clams for noncommercial purposes;
23	"(f) Monitoring the take of bay clams;
24	"(g) Establishing additional restrictions on the annual take of bay clams in intertidal and
25	subtidal areas in Oregon bays;
26	"(h) Limiting the take of bay clams in Oregon bays for commercial purposes; and
27	"(i) Assessing bay clam populations in Oregon bays.
28	"(4) The department shall consider the recommendations of the committee.
29	"(5) The committee shall assist the department in preparing any funding requests related
30	to bay clams.
31	"(6) In addition to the recommendations identified in subsection (3) of this section, the
32	committee may advise the department on other matters related to bay clams.
33	"SECTION 3. (1) The Tillamook Bay Clam Advisory Committee established under section
34	2 of this 2019 Act shall begin meeting in 2020.
35	"(2) To facilitate the actions required by subsection (1) of this section, the State De-

1 partment of Fish and Wildlife shall appoint persons to the committee as soon as practicable

2 after the effective date of this 2019 Act.

³ "<u>SECTION 4.</u> On or before December 31, 2022, the State Department of Fish and Wildlife
⁴ shall report to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly relating to natural re⁵ sources, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, on the recommendations of the Tillamook
⁶ Bay Clam Advisory Committee established under section 2 of this 2019 Act.".
