

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 107

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 3, after “ORS” insert “811.550 and”.

2 On page 2, delete lines 13 and 14 and insert:

3 “(12)(a) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles owned or operated by an electric
4 utility when stopping, standing or parking is necessary to respond to an emergency if the vehicle
5 is identified as an electric utility vehicle and:

6 “(A) There is also an emergency vehicle at the location; or

7 “(B) The electric utility is investigating a downed or arcing utility line.

8 “(b) As used in this subsection, ‘electric utility’ means an electric company or consumer-owned
9 utility that is engaged in the business of distributing electricity to retail electricity consumers in
10 this state.

11 “**SECTION 2.** ORS 811.550 is amended to read:

12 “811.550. This section establishes places where stopping, standing and parking a vehicle are
13 prohibited for purposes of the penalties under ORS 811.555. Except as provided under an exemption
14 in ORS 811.560, a person is in violation of ORS 811.555 if a person parks, stops or leaves standing
15 a vehicle in any of the following places:

16 “(1) Upon a roadway outside a business district or residence district, whether attended or un-
17 attended, when it is practicable to stop, park or leave the vehicle standing off the roadway. Ex-
18 emptions under ORS 811.560 (1), (7), [and] (9), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

19 “(2) On a shoulder, whether attended or unattended, unless a clear and unobstructed width of
20 the roadway opposite the standing vehicle is left for the passage of other vehicles and the standing
21 vehicle is visible from a distance of 200 feet in each direction upon the roadway or the person, at
22 least 200 feet in each direction upon the roadway, warns approaching motorists of the standing ve-
23 hicle by use of flaggers, flags, signs or other signals. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (9), **(11) and**
24 **(12)** are applicable to this subsection.

25 “(3) On the roadway side of a vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a highway. Ex-
26 emptions under ORS 811.560 (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

27 “(4) On a sidewalk. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this
28 subsection.

29 “(5) Within an intersection. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applica-
30 ble to this subsection.

31 “(6) On a crosswalk. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to
32 this subsection.

33 “(7) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within 30 feet of points on the curb imme-
34 diately opposite the ends of a safety zone, unless a different length is indicated by signs and
35 markings. For purposes of this subsection the safety zone must be an area or space officially set

1 apart within a roadway for the exclusive use of pedestrians and which is protected or is so marked
2 or indicated by adequate signs as to be plainly visible at all times while set apart as a safety zone.
3 Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

4 “(8) Alongside or opposite a street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing or parking
5 would obstruct traffic. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this
6 subsection.

7 “(9) Upon a bridge or other elevated structure upon a highway. Exemptions under ORS 811.560
8 (4) to (8), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

9 “(10) Within a highway tunnel. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are ap-
10 plicable to this subsection.

11 “(11) On any railroad or rail fixed guideway public transportation system tracks or within seven
12 and one-half feet of the nearest rail at a time when the parking of vehicles would conflict with op-
13 erations or repair of the tracks. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are appli-
14 cable to this subsection.

15 “(12) On a throughway. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable
16 to this subsection.

17 “(13) In the area between roadways of a divided highway, including crossovers. Exemptions un-
18 der ORS 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

19 “(14) At any place where traffic control devices prohibit stopping. Exemptions under ORS
20 811.560 (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

21 “(15) In front of a public or private driveway. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (2), [and] (4) to
22 (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

23 “(16) Within 10 feet of a fire hydrant. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (2), [and] (4) to (7), **(11)**
24 **and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

25 “(17) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (2),
26 [and] (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

27 “(18) Within 50 feet upon the approach to an official flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign or
28 traffic control device located at the side of the roadway if the standing or parking of a vehicle will
29 obstruct the view of any traffic control device located at the side of the roadway. Exemptions under
30 ORS 811.560 (2), [and] (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

31 “(19) Within 15 feet of the driveway entrance to a fire station and on the side of a street op-
32 posite the entrance to a fire station, within 75 feet of the entrance. Exemptions under ORS 811.560
33 (2), [and] (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

34 “(20) At any place where traffic control devices prohibit standing. Exemptions under ORS
35 811.560 (2), [and] (4) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

36 “(21) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad or rail fixed guideway public transportation
37 system crossing. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 (3) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this sub-
38 section.

39 “(22) At any place where traffic control devices prohibit parking. Exemptions under ORS 811.560
40 (3) to (7), **(11) and (12)** are applicable to this subsection.

41 “(23) On a bicycle lane. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 are applicable to this subsection.

42 “(24) On a bicycle path. Exemptions under ORS 811.560 are applicable to this subsection.

43 “**SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 811.550 and 811.560 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2019**
44 **Act apply to conduct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2019 Act.**”.
