

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 155

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 25 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 28 through 31 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 21.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
3 ation made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (1), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws  
4 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), for central services and state assessments and enterprise-  
5 wide costs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, is increased by \$1,344,780 for the purpose  
6 of complying with the requirements of this 2019 Act.

7 “**SECTION 21a.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
8 ation made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (3), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws  
9 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), for child welfare, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, is  
10 increased by \$1,116,115 for the purpose of complying with the requirements of this 2019 Act.

11 “**SECTION 21b.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
12 expenditures established by section 2 (5), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill  
13 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses  
14 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts  
15 and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security  
16 Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and  
17 federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Department of Human  
18 Services, for shared services, is increased by \$820,749 for the purpose of complying with the  
19 requirements of this 2019 Act.

20 “**SECTION 21c.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
21 expenditures established by section 3 (1), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill  
22 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses  
23 from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws  
24 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), collected or received by the Department of Human Services,  
25 for central services and state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$392,329  
26 for the purpose of complying with the requirements of this 2019 Act.”.

27 On page 31, delete lines 22 through 26 and insert:

28 “**SECTION 30.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
29 expenditures established by section 1, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled Senate Bill  
30 5537), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses  
31 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery  
32 funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Teacher Standards and Practices Com-  
33 mission, is increased by \$525,000 for the purpose of complying with the requirements of sec-  
34 tion 23 of this 2019 Act.”.

35 On page 33, delete lines 28 through 31 and insert:

1           **“SECTION 34. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-**  
2 **ation made to the Department of Education by section 1 (1), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2019**  
3 **(Enrolled House Bill 5015), for operations, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, is in-**  
4 **creased by \$1,621,607 for the purpose of complying with the requirements of section 32 of this**  
5 **2019 Act.”**

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
