CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to taxation; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. If section 63, chapter 122, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427), does not become law by March 1, 2020, sections 1 to 3, 6 to 20, 22 to 25, 27, 29 to 33, 35 to 54 and 67, chapter 122, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427), and the amendments to statutes by sections 4, 5, 21, 26, 28, 34, 55 and 56, chapter 122, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427), do not take effect.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
