

# Senate Bill 220

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Office of the Governor)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to conduct study related to greenhouse gas emissions.

Sunsets January 2, 2022.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to greenhouse gas emissions.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall conduct a study to ex-**  
5 **amine the possibility of developing a program for regulating greenhouse gas emissions in this**  
6 **state and emissions of greenhouse gases from outside this state that are attributable to the**  
7 **generation of electricity that is delivered to and consumed in this state, and shall make a**  
8 **report on its findings.**

9 **(2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and**  
10 **may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative**  
11 **Assembly related to environment and natural resources in the manner provided by ORS**  
12 **192.245 no later than September 15, 2021.**

13 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2022.**
