

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 221

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “needs” insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

2 Delete lines 4 through 7 and insert:

3 “**SECTION 1.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
4 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the
5 General Fund, the amount of \$6,600,000, which may be expended for intensive in-home ser-
6 vices for children with behavioral health needs.

7 “**SECTION 2.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
8 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the
9 General Fund, the amount of \$3,076,000, which may be expended to support statewide imple-
10 mentation of crisis and transition services.

11 “**SECTION 3.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
12 priated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out
13 of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,600,000, which may be expended beginning July 1, 2020,
14 to support implementation of the federal Family First Prevention Services Act, 132 Stat. 232
15 (2018), by funding evidence-based prevention services that are flexible enough to support
16 families in their homes, schools and communities.

17 “**SECTION 4.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
18 priated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out
19 of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,500,000, which may be expended for therapeutic foster
20 care.

21 “**SECTION 5. (1)** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-
22 propriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019,
23 out of the General Fund, the amount of \$8,400,000, which may be expended to supplement
24 existing programs to include enhanced services for children with intellectual or develop-
25 mental disabilities, including but not limited to children with intellectual or developmental
26 disabilities who may also have behavioral health needs.

27 “**(2)** The department shall prioritize expenditures described in subsection (1) of this sec-
28 tion for services that prevent out-of-home care or that are provided in settings that include
29 children with and without intellectual and developmental disabilities.

30 “**SECTION 6.** This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
31 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect
32 on July 1, 2019.”
