

Senate Bill 230

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits Department of Veterans' Affairs to disclose names and electronic mail addresses of veterans to certain committees of Legislative Assembly. Permits members and staff members of committee to use such information only to communicate with veterans for legislative purposes. Prohibits other use or disclosure.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to disclosure of contact information of veterans.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Veterans' Affairs may, upon request from a standing**
5 **or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly with subject matter jurisdiction over**
6 **veterans' affairs, disclose names and electronic mail addresses of veterans to the committee.**

7 **(2) A member or staff member of a committee of the Legislative Assembly who receives**
8 **names or electronic mail addresses of veterans under this section:**

9 **(a) May use such information only to communicate with veterans for legislative purposes;**
10 **and**

11 **(b) May not use or disclose such information for any other purposes.**
