

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 283

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 24 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1)(a) The Oregon Health Authority shall:**

3 **“(A) Review peer-reviewed, independently funded scientific studies of the health effects**
4 **of exposure to microwave radiation, particularly exposure that results from the use of**
5 **wireless network technologies in schools or similar environments; and**

6 **“(B) Report the results of the review to an interim committee of the Legislative Assem-**
7 **bly related to education not later than January 2, 2021.**

8 **“(b) The review described in paragraph (a) of this subsection must, at a minimum, con-**
9 **sist of a literature review of peer-reviewed, independently funded scientific studies that ex-**
10 **amine the health effects of exposure to microwave radiation on children.**

11 **“(2) The Department of Education shall develop recommendations to schools in this state**
12 **for practices and alternative technologies that would reduce students’ exposure to micro-**
13 **wave radiation that the review described in subsection (1) of this section identifies as**
14 **harmful.**

15 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
16 **priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the**
17 **General Fund, the amount of \$10,000 for the purpose of carrying out the authority’s func-**
18 **tions and duties under section 1 of this 2019 Act.**

19 **“SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
21 **on its passage.”.**
