

Senate Bill 387

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows medical marijuana processing site to transfer certain medical marijuana products to person responsible for producing medical marijuana under specified conditions.
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transfer of usable marijuana; amending ORS 475B.852; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 475B.852 is amended to read:

5 475B.852. (1)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, a marijuana processing
6 site may not transfer medical cannabinoid products, cannabinoid concentrates or cannabinoid ex-
7 tracts to a person other than another marijuana processing site or a medical marijuana dispensary.

8 (b) A marijuana processing site may transfer a medical cannabinoid product, cannabinoid con-
9 centrate or cannabinoid extract to a registry identification cardholder, [or] the designated primary
10 caregiver of a registry identification cardholder[, *provided that*] **or a person designated to produce**
11 **marijuana by a registry identification cardholder if:**

12 (A) The registry identification cardholder, [or] designated primary caregiver **or person desig-**
13 **nated to produce marijuana** provides the marijuana processing site with the marijuana to be pro-
14 cessed into the medical cannabinoid product, cannabinoid concentrate or cannabinoid extract; and

15 (B) The marijuana processing site [*receives no*] **does not receive** compensation for the transfer.

16 (c) A registry identification cardholder, [or] the designated primary caregiver of a registry
17 identification cardholder **or a person designated to produce marijuana by a registry identifi-**
18 **cation cardholder**[,] may reimburse a marijuana processing site for all costs associated with the
19 processing of marijuana for the registry identification cardholder.

20 (2) A person other than a marijuana processing site may not transfer medical cannabinoid pro-
21 ducts, cannabinoid concentrates or cannabinoid extracts to a medical marijuana dispensary.

22 **SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 475B.825 by section 1 of this 2019 Act become op-**
23 **erative on January 1, 2020.**

24 **SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
25 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
