SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Governor or designee to notify presiding judge of circuit court of county of conviction within 10 days of granting pardon. Directs presiding judge to, upon receipt of notification, issue order sealing record of conviction and other official records of case.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to pardons. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. (1) When the Governor grants a pardon, the Governor or the Governor's 4 designee shall within 10 days notify the presiding judge of the circuit court of the county in 5 which the pardoned conviction occurred. 6

(2) Upon receipt of the notification described in subsection (1) of this section, the pre-7 siding judge shall issue an order sealing the record of conviction and other official records 8 in the case, including the records of arrest, citation or charge. The clerk of the court shall 9 forward a certified copy of the order to such agencies as directed by the court. 10 11
