

Senate Bill 399

Sponsored by Senator BENTZ (at the request of Kim Barry) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Eliminates requirement that applicant for property services contractor license pass qualifying examination.

2 Relating to licensing requirements for property services contractors; amending ORS 658.412.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 658.412, as amended by section 4, chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2018, is amended
5 to read:

6 658.412. (1) The Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries may not issue a license to
7 operate as a labor contractor until an applicant for a license has successfully passed a qualifying
8 examination designed to test the applicant's ability, knowledge and proficiency to conduct and
9 manage the business of a labor contractor. The examination must also test the applicant's knowledge
10 of an employer's responsibility to prevent sexual assault and sexual harassment. The commissioner
11 shall prescribe by rule the requirements for and the manner of testing the competency of license
12 applicants.

13 *[(2) In prescribing requirements for testing applicants for a property services contractor license, the*
14 *commissioner may establish a process to administer the examination in-person, through an online elec-*
15 *tronic medium or in any other manner as the commissioner may specify.]*

16 **(2) The examination requirements of this section do not apply to applicants for a property**
17 **services contractor license.**
