## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 496

Delete lines 4 through 26 of the printed bill and insert: 1

2 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:

3 "(a) 'Alternative education student' means a student who is part of a school or a separate class group that was designed to best serve the student's educational needs and interests and 4  $\mathbf{5}$ to assist the student in achieving the academic standards of the school district and the state.

"(b) 'English language learner' has the meaning given that term in ORS 336.079.

7 "(c) 'Special education student' means a student who is receiving special education or related services, as provided by ORS chapter 343. 8

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"(d) 'Specialized learning area' includes laboratories, auditoriums and athletic facilities.

10 "(e) 'Traditional student' means a student who is not an alternative education student, 11 an English language learner or a special education student.

12 "(2) For an alternative education student, an English language learner or a special edu-13 cation student, a school district may not restrict access to specialized learning areas or to 14 the common lunch area, common gathering areas or recreational areas in a manner that is 15different than any restrictions imposed on traditional students in the same grade.

"(3) Nothing in subsection (2) of this section prevents a school district from: 16

17 "(a) Implementing a behavior support or safety plan that restricts a student's access to 18 common or specialized learning areas based on the specific documented needs or behaviors 19 of the student;

20 "(b) Imposing discipline that prohibits a student from accessing specific common or spe-21cialized learning areas for a defined period of time and for reasons specific to the student's 22behavior; or

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"(c) Complying with any order from a court or law enforcement agency.".

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
