Senate Bill 534

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires city to allow single-family dwellings in residential lots platted and zoned for such uses.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to single-family dwellings in residential areas.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 227.
5	SECTION 2. A city may not prohibit the building of a single-family dwelling on lots within
6	the urban growth boundary and zoned to allow for single-family dwellings, unless the prohi-
7	bition is based on:
8	(1) The lot's inability to be adequately served by water, sewer or streets;
9	(2) The lot being too small or too steep to accommodate a single-family dwelling; or
10	(3) A land use regulation based on a statewide land use planning goal relating to natural
11	resources and the conservation of scenic areas and open spaces, but not including a regu-
12	lation designed to protect historic areas.
