

Senate Bill 544

Sponsored by Senator RILEY (at the request of Annette Cornish) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires ambulances to carry emergency treatment medication for adrenal insufficiency disorder. Authorizes Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to adrenal insufficiency; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "ambulance" has the meaning given that term**
5 **in ORS 682.025.**

6 **(2) An ambulance shall carry emergency treatment medication for adrenal insufficiency**
7 **disorder.**

8 **(3) The Oregon Health Authority may adopt rules to carry out this section, including**
9 **rules regarding training on the use of emergency treatment medication for adrenal insuffi-**
10 **ciency disorder and best practices for administering emergency treatment medication for**
11 **adrenal insufficiency disorder.**

12 **SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2020.**

13 **(2) The Oregon Health Authority may take any action before the operative date specified**
14 **in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the authority to exercise, on and**
15 **after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions**
16 **and powers conferred on the authority by section 1 of this 2019 Act.**

17 **SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
18 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
