

# Enrolled Senate Bill 5515

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Justice; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:

- (1) **Office of the Attorney General and Administration**..... \$ 744,939
- (2) **Appellate Division**..... \$ 350,507
- (3) **Criminal Justice Division**..... \$ 14,940,476
- (4) **Crime Victim and Survivor Services**..... \$ 14,341,791
- (5) **Defense of Criminal Convictions**..... \$ 27,892,449
- (6) **Division of Child Support**..... \$ 36,352,778
- (7) **Child Support Enforcement Automated System**..... \$ 2,137,146
- (8) **Debt service and related costs**..... \$ 14,165,382

**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Justice, for the following purposes:

- (1) **Office of the Attorney General and administration**..... \$ 39,896,329
- (2) **Appellate Division**..... \$ 23,851,965
- (3) **Civil Enforcement Division**..... \$113,441,977
- (4) **Criminal Justice Division**..... \$ 9,665,093
- (5) **Crime Victim and Survivor Services**..... \$ 30,400,379
- (6) **General Counsel Division**..... \$ 66,145,693
- (7) **Trial Division**..... \$ 39,042,838

- (8) Division of Child Support..... \$ 27,501,439
- (9) Child Support Enforcement  
Automated System..... \$ 3,687,823

**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Justice for the following purposes:

- (1) Civil Enforcement Division..... \$ 4,992,035
- (2) Criminal Justice Division..... \$ 1,433,726
- (3) Crime Victim and Survivor  
Services Division..... \$ 50,242,262
- (4) Division of Child Support..... \$119,535,778
- (5) Child Support Enforcement  
Automated System..... \$ 11,307,249

**SECTION 4.** This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect July 1, 2019.
