

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5517

4 In line 15, delete “\$20,720,572” and insert “\$23,337,046”.

5 In line 18, delete “\$11,433,317” and insert “\$12,533,782”.

6 In line 29, delete “\$14,346,970” and insert “\$14,727,985”.

7 In line 31, delete “\$1,908,386” and insert “\$2,006,234”.

8 In line 41, delete “\$6,092,019” and insert “\$7,838,317”.

13 Delete lines 12 through 14 and insert:

14 **“SECTION 18. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
15 **expenditures established by section 13 (2), chapter 577, Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium**
16 **ending June 30, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or**
17 **other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal**
18 **funds, collected or received by the Legislative Fiscal Officer, is increased by \$380,000.**

19 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
20 **to the Legislative Assembly by section 7 (2), chapter 577, Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium**
21 **ending June 30, 2019, is decreased by \$1,000,000.**

22 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
23 **to the Legislative Assembly by section 6, chapter 577, Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium**
24 **ending June 30, 2019, is increased by \$1,000,000.**

25 **“SECTION 19. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
26 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
27 **on its passage.”.**
