## Senate Bill 5527

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## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Parks and Recreation Department for biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes. Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Parks and Recreation Department, for the

biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$273,580 for the
expenses of the director's office.
