

# Enrolled Senate Bill 5532

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Public Defense Services Commission; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Public Defense Services Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

- (1) Appellate Division..... \$ 22,637,870
- (2) Professional services..... \$309,304,337
- (3) Contract and Business Services Division..... \$ 6,982,059

**SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Defense Services Commission, for the following purposes:**

- (1) Professional services..... \$ 3,200,000
- (2) Contract and Business Services Division..... \$ 536,398

**SECTION 3. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000, to be allocated to the Public Defense Services Commission for acquisition of a new financial management system.**

**(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2020, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

**SECTION 4. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect July 1, 2019.**
