

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 582

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Governor may enter into an agreement with another state for the**  
3 **purposes of:**

4 **“(a) Cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement of marijuana-related businesses**  
5 **authorized to conduct business in either this state or the other state; and**

6 **“(b) Cross-jurisdictional delivery of marijuana items between this state and the other**  
7 **state.**

8 **“(2) An agreement entered into under this section:**

9 **“(a) Must ensure enforceable public health and safety standards, and include a system**  
10 **to regulate and track the interstate delivery of marijuana items;**

11 **“(b) Must ensure that any marijuana items delivered into this state, prior to sale to a**  
12 **consumer, are:**

13 **“(A) Tested in accordance with ORS 475B.550 to 475B.590 and any rules adopted pursuant**  
14 **to ORS 475B.550 to 475B.590; and**

15 **“(B) Packaged and labeled in accordance with ORS 475B.600 to 475B.655 and any rules**  
16 **adopted pursuant to ORS 475B.600 to 475B.655; and**

17 **“(c) May authorize one or more agencies of this state to provide policy recommendations**  
18 **and assist in the implementation and enforcement of the terms of the agreement.**

19 **“(3) Notwithstanding ORS 475B.227 and in accordance with an agreement described in**  
20 **this section:**

21 **“(a) A marijuana producer, marijuana processor, marijuana wholesaler or marijuana re-**  
22 **searcher certified under ORS 475B.286 may deliver marijuana items to a person located in,**  
23 **and authorized to receive marijuana items by, the other state.**

24 **“(b) A marijuana processor, marijuana wholesaler, marijuana retailer or marijuana re-**  
25 **searcher certified under ORS 475B.286 may receive marijuana items from a person located**  
26 **in, and authorized to export marijuana items by, the other state.**

27 **“SECTION 3. (1) Section 2 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on the earlier of the date**  
28 **on which:**

29 **“(a) Federal law is amended to allow for the interstate transfer of marijuana items be-**  
30 **tween authorized marijuana-related businesses; or**

31 **“(b) The United States Department of Justice issues an opinion or memorandum allowing**  
32 **or tolerating the interstate transfer of marijuana items between authorized marijuana-**  
33 **related businesses.**

34 **“(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall notify the interim committees of the**  
35 **Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary and the Legislative Counsel upon the occur-**

1 **rence of an event described in subsection (1) of this section.”.**
