

# Senate Bill 591

Sponsored by Senator PROZANSKI, Representative BARKER, Senators ROBLAN, WINTERS, Representatives HOLVEY, NOBLE (at the request of Oregon Winegrowers Association) (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Makes violation of statutes or rules regarding minimum standards for wine, or branding or labeling requirements for wine, unlawful trade practice.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to unlawful trade practices regarding wine.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 471.**

5 **SECTION 2. A person engages in an unlawful practice in violation of ORS 646.608 if the**  
6 **person violates:**

7 (1) **ORS 471.442 or 471.446 (2) with regard to wine;**

8 (2) **Any minimum standards for wine established by rule; or**

9 (3) **Any branding or labeling requirements for wine established by rule.**
