

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 690

By COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon insert “amending sections 3, 4 and 5, chapter
2 110, Oregon Laws 2014;”.

3 After line 4, insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** Section 3, chapter 110, Oregon Laws 2014, is amended to read:

5 “**Sec. 3.** There is established a State Council for Educational Opportunity for Military Children,
6 as described in Article VIII of the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military
7 Children under section 1, **chapter 110, Oregon Laws 2014** [*of this 2014 Act*], consisting of **the**
8 **Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction, the members of the State Board of Education,**
9 the military family education liaison and the compact commissioner. The Governor may appoint
10 other individuals to the state council and shall make a good faith effort to ensure that other indi-
11 viduals appointed are individuals who are described in Article VIII of the Interstate Compact on
12 Educational Opportunity for Military Children under section 1, **chapter 110, Oregon Laws 2014,**
13 [*of this 2014 Act*] and who are well informed on the principles of education of military children.

14 “**SECTION 2.** Section 4, chapter 110, Oregon Laws 2014, is amended to read:

15 “**Sec. 4.** The State Council for Educational Opportunity for Military Children shall meet at least
16 once [*every three months*] **each calendar year** through the use of telephone or other electronic
17 means and in accordance with ORS 192.610 to 192.690 and 192.672.

18 “**SECTION 3.** Section 5, chapter 110, Oregon Laws 2014, is amended to read:

19 “**Sec. 5.** The [*Oregon Military Department*] **Department of Education** shall provide adminis-
20 trative support to the State Council for Educational Opportunity for Military Children.”.

21 In line 5, delete “1” and insert “4”.

22 In line 6, delete “2” and insert “5”.
