Senate Bill 827

Sponsored by Senator GELSER; Senators DEMBROW, GOLDEN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows brewery licensee or brewery-public house licensee to sell and dispense malt beverages at special event from mobile sources at nonfixed locations.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to alcoholic beverages; amending ORS 471.159.
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
SECTION 1. ORS 471.159 is amended to read:
471.159. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may not license a location that does not
have defined boundaries.
(2) A licensed premises need not be enclosed by a wall, fence or other structure, but the com-
mission may require that any licensed premises be enclosed as a condition of issuing or renewing
a license.
(3) Except as provided in ORS 471.182, the commission may not license premises that are mobile.
However, the commission shall allow a holder of a brewery license or brewery-public house
license to sell and dispense malt beverages from mobile sources operating at nonfixed points
within the defined boundaries of a location for which a special events brewery license or
special events brewery-public house license has been issued.
