

Senate Bill 840

Sponsored by Senator THOMSEN; Representative SMITH DB

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that, for purposes of determining eligibility of municipalities in counties with population of 50,000 or less for financial or other assistance for public works projects, Oregon Business Development Department may waive or modify application of any rule of department relating to job creation and retention, hiring or employment.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to employment requirements for public works projects; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 285B.410 to**
5 **285B.482.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) This section applies to municipalities in counties with a population of**
7 **50,000 or less.**

8 **(2) For purposes of determining the eligibility of a municipality for financial or other**
9 **assistance under ORS 285B.410 to 285B.482, the Oregon Business Development Department**
10 **may waive or modify the application of any rule of the department relating to job creation**
11 **and retention, hiring or employment.**

12 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2019 Act applies to applications for financial or other as-**
13 **sistance under ORS 285B.410 to 285B.482 filed on or after the effective date of this 2019 Act.**

14 **SECTION 4. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
16 **on its passage.**
