## Senate Bill 863

Sponsored by Senator BEYER (at the request of Oregon Seed Association)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires seed producers and growers to obtain licenses.

Requires seed producers, growers and wholesalers to annually report seed varieties and amounts of seed produced, grown or purchased during previous calendar year.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to seed licenses; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 633.700.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 633.700 is amended to read:

633.700. (1) A person may not sell, offer or expose for sale in this state, or contract to have  $\mathbf{5}$ produced in this state for commercial purposes, any agricultural, flower or vegetable seeds unless 6 7 the person holds an unsuspended license issued by the State Department of Agriculture. However, a person is not required to obtain a license under this subsection if the person is selling only seeds 8 produced by the person or if the person is selling flower or vegetable seeds at retail in packages 9 weighing not more than one-half pound that were prepared for retail sale by a seed company li-10 censed under this section. For the purposes of this section, persons operating more than one branch, 11 12 plant or warehouse where seeds are sold, offered or exposed for sale shall secure a separate license 13for each such branch, plant or warehouse.

14 (2) Any person desiring to sell, offer or expose for sale in this state any agricultural, flower or vegetable seeds, for planting purposes, except as provided in this section, shall make application to 15 16 the Director of Agriculture for a license for this purpose. The application shall be signed by the 17applicant or the authorized agent of the applicant and shall be in a form approved by the director. Upon presentation of such signed application for a license and the tendering of the license fee es-18 19 tablished by the department pursuant to subsection [(3)] (4) of this section, the department shall is-20 sue the license to the applicant. The license shall expire on June 30 next following the date of issuance or on such date as may be specified by department rule. 21

22(3) Any producer or seed grower, as those terms are defined in ORS 576.715 or section 231, chapter 26, Oregon Laws 2018, desiring to grow or produce seeds in this state on a commercial basis shall make application to the director for a license for this purpose. The ap-2425plication shall be signed by the applicant or the authorized agent of the applicant and shall 26 be in a form approved by the director. Upon presentation of such signed application for a license and the tendering of the license fee established by the department pursuant to sub-27 section (4) of this section, the department shall issue the license to the applicant. The 28 license shall expire on June 30 next following the date of issuance or on such date as may 29 be specified by department rule. 30

[(3)] (4) The department shall require only one license for one person's operation at one

1	location and establish annual license fees, not to exceed:
<b>2</b>	(a) \$75 for a retailer's license [and not to exceed];
3	(b) \$750 for a wholesaler's license[. Only one license shall be required for one person's operation
4	at one location.]; or
5	(c) \$ for a producer's or seed grower's license.
6	SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:
7	(a) "Seed production contract" means a contract defined as a seed production contract
8	under ORS 576.715 to 576.744 or sections 1 to 10, chapter 26, Oregon Laws 2018.
9	(b) "Variety" means a subdivision of a kind that is:
10	(A) Characterized by growth, plant, fruit, seed or another characteristic by which it can
11	be distinguished from other sorts of the same kind; and
12	(B) Recognized as a variety under rules adopted by the State Department of Agriculture.
13	(2) A person that holds a license under ORS 633.700 (2) shall annually report to the State
14	Department of Agriculture, for seed purchased by the person under a seed production con-
15	tract during the previous calendar year:
16	(a) The amount of the seed; and
17	(b) The varieties of the seed.
18	(3) A person that holds a license under ORS 633.700 (3) shall annually report to the de-
19	partment, for seed produced or grown by the person during the previous calendar year:
20	(a) The acreage of the seed; and
21	(b) The varieties of the seed.
