

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 924

- 1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 3, after “169.085,” insert “417.020,”.
- 2 In line 5, after “419B.185,” insert “419C.010,”.
- 3 On page 11, line 24, after “Compact” delete the rest of the line and delete line 25 and insert
- 4 “for Juveniles as set forth in ORS 417.030.”.
- 5 On page 13, after line 18, insert:
- 6 “**SECTION 22.** ORS 417.020 is amended to read:
- 7 “417.020. (1) It hereby is found and declared that:
- 8 “(a) Juveniles who are not under proper supervision and control, or who have absconded, es-
- 9 caped or run away, are likely to endanger their own health, morals and welfare, and the health,
- 10 morals and welfare of others; and
- 11 “(b) The cooperation of this state with other states is necessary to provide for the welfare and
- 12 protection of juveniles and of the people of this state.
- 13 “(2) It is therefore the policy of this state, in adopting the Interstate Compact [*on*] **for** Juveniles,
- 14 to cooperate fully with other states in returning juveniles to such other states whenever their return
- 15 is sought, to accept the return of juveniles whenever a juvenile residing in this state is found or
- 16 apprehended in another state and to take all measures to initiate proceedings for the return of such
- 17 juveniles.
- 18 “**SECTION 23.** ORS 419C.010 is amended to read:
- 19 “419C.010. (1) The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to a youth who, while under the
- 20 age of 18 years, commits an act which is a violation, or which if done by an adult would constitute
- 21 a violation, of a law or ordinance of this state or any of its political subdivisions, punishable by
- 22 imprisonment, and thereafter flees from this state.
- 23 “(2) The youth described in subsection (1) of this section may be proceeded against in the man-
- 24 ner provided in ORS 133.743 to 133.857.
- 25 “(3) Upon the return of the youth described in subsection (1) of this section to this state by
- 26 extradition or otherwise, any proceedings against the youth shall be commenced in the same manner
- 27 as provided in this chapter.
- 28 “(4) If a youth described in subsection (1) of this section has fled to a state which has adopted
- 29 the Rendition Amendment to the Interstate Compact [*on*] **for** Juveniles, the return of the youth shall
- 30 be sought in accordance with the provisions of that compact.”.
- 31 In line 19, delete “22” and insert “24” and delete “21” and insert “23”.
- 32 In line 22, delete “23” and insert “25”.
