## AN ACT

Relating to inquiries issued by public bodies about race or ethnicity.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> A form or document issued by a public body, as defined in ORS 174.109, that asks a person to identify the person's race or ethnicity must allow the person to select multiple races or ethnicities.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2023.
