

Senate Bill 949

Sponsored by Senators DEMBROW, HANSELL, PROZANSKI, Representative WILLIAMSON; Representative NOSSE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for purposes of prison education programs.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
6 **2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$350,000 for distribution to the University of**
7 **Oregon for the purposes of providing and expanding educational programs in Oregon**
8 **correctional facilities.**

9 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
10 **ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
11 **2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$150,000 for distribution to Blue Mountain**
12 **Community College for the purposes of providing and expanding educational programs in**
13 **Oregon correctional facilities.**

14 **SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
16 **July 1, 2019.**
