PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2416

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28 and delete <u>page</u> 2 2 and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'small home' means a ve hicle that:

5 "(a) Is not designed for self-propulsion;

6 "(b) Is suitable for full-time or part-time residential use;

7 "(c) Is not more than eight and one-half feet wide; and

8 "(d) Is not more than 400 square feet in area.

9 "(2) The owner of a small home may register the home with the 10 Department of Transportation as a recreational vehicle if the home:

"(a) Is constructed on, and permanently attached to, a wheeled
 chassis that is appropriate for the small home to be towed on the road;

13 **"(b) Bears a vehicle identification number;**

14 "(c) Lacks permanent direct attachments to utilities; and

15 "(d) Is not permanently attached to land.

"(3) The owner of a small home that is registered with the depart ment as a recreational vehicle shall, at the time the department issues
 or renews the registration, file with the department a form attesting
 that the home:

20 "(a) Is still permanently attached to a wheeled chassis;

21 "(b) Does not have permanent direct attachments to utilities; and

1 "(c) Is not permanently attached to land.

"(4) The department may not issue or renew the registration of a
small home as a recreational vehicle unless the owner has filed the
form described in subsection (3) of this section.

5 "(5) A small home that meets the qualifications established in sub-6 section (2) of this section and is registered with the department as a 7 recreational vehicle is exempt from the state building code.

8 "(6) The department shall revoke the registration of a small home
9 if the department discovers that the home:

10 "(a) Is no longer permanently attached to a wheeled chassis;

11 "(b) Has permanent direct attachments to utilities; or

12 "(c) Is permanently attached to land.

"(7) If the department revokes a registration under subsection (6)
 of this section, the department shall give notice of the revocation to
 the Department of Consumer and Business Services.

"(8) A person that makes a false attestation in a form described in
 subsection (3) of this section commits an offense under ORS 803.375.

"SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part
 of ORS chapter 455.

20 "SECTION 3. A small home described in section 1 of this 2019 Act 21 ceases to be exempt from the state building code if:

"(1) The wheeled chassis is not appropriate for the small home to
be towed on the road;

24 "(2) The small home lacks a vehicle identification number;

25 "(3) The small home is no longer permanently attached to the
 26 wheeled chassis;

"(4) The small home has permanent direct attachments to utilities;
"(5) The small home is permanently attached to land; or

"(6) The small home lacks a valid registration with the Department
 of Transportation as a recreational vehicle.

1 "SECTION 4. (1) As used in this section:

"(a) 'Living area components' means flooring, roofing, building envelope, plumbing systems, electrical systems and heating and air conditioning systems.

5 "(b) 'Small home' means a vehicle that:

6 "(A) Is not designed for self-propulsion;

7 "(B) Is suitable for full-time or part-time residential use;

8 "(C) Is not more than eight and one-half feet wide; and

9 "(D) Is not more than 400 square feet in area.

"(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, a man ufacturer of a small home shall warrant the living area components
 against defects in materials or workmanship for one year following the
 initial sale of the home to a consumer if the small home:

"(a) Is constructed on, and permanently attached to, a wheeled
 chassis that is appropriate for the small home to be towed on the road;
 and

"(3) A manufacturer warranty required under subsection (2) of this
 section terminates if the small home:

20 "(a) Is no longer permanently attached to a wheeled chassis;

21 "(b) Has permanent direct attachments to utilities;

22 "(c) Is permanently attached to land; or

"(d) Lacks a valid registration with the Department of Transportation as a recreational vehicle.".

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
