4 **"SECTION 3.** ORS 676.820 is amended to read:

676.820. (1) An individual licensed under ORS 676.810 or registered under
ORS 676.815 may practice applied behavior analysis.

"(2) An individual may not practice applied behavior analysis for the
purpose of treating a mental, emotional or behavioral disorder unless
the individual is licensed under ORS 676.810 or registered under ORS
676.815. This subsection does not apply to:

11 "(a) A licensed health care professional; or

"(b) A family member of a patient if the family member is acting
 at the direction of an individual licensed under ORS 676.810 or a li censed health care professional.

"[(2)] (3) Only an individual who is licensed under ORS 676.810 or registered under ORS 676.815 may use the title 'licensed behavior analyst,' 'licensed assistant behavior analyst' or 'registered behavior analysis interventionist.'

"(4) A penalty for a violation of subsection (2) of this section may
be imposed in addition to other applicable disciplinary actions that
may be imposed by a board listed in ORS 676.802.

"SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2019 Act and the amendments to ORS
676.820 by section 3 of this 2019 Act apply to acts performed on or after
the operative date specified in section 5 of this 2019 Act.

"<u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) Section 2 of this 2019 Act and the amendments to
ORS 676.820 by section 3 of this 2019 Act become operative on January
1, 2020.

"(2) The Health Licensing Office and the boards listed in ORS 676.802 may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the office and the boards to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the office and the boards by section 2 of this 2019 Act and the amendments to ORS 676.820 by section 3 of this 2019 Act.

"<u>SECTION 6.</u> This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
 date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative
 Assembly adjourns sine die.".
