## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2651

In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line and insert "creating new provisions; and amending ORS 352.089.".

3 Delete lines 4 through 22 and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. ORS 352.089 is amended to read:

"352.089. (1) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall adopt a
mission statement for the university, and shall forward the statement to the
Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

"(2)(a) [A public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall submit any signif-8 icant change in the university's academic programs to the Higher Education 9 10 Coordinating Commission. The commission shall establish a process for reviewing the significant program change for approval.] A public university 11 listed in ORS 352.002 that intends to make a significant change to the 12 university's academic programs shall notify the Higher Education Co-13 ordinating Commission of the university's intention at the time the 14 university begins preliminary planning for the significant change. The 15university must submit a request for and obtain the commission's 16 approval before making any actual plans. The commission shall es-17 tablish a process for reviewing and approving a university's request. 18 The commission shall establish, by rule, what constitutes a significant 19 change to a university's academic program. The commission shall further 20ensure that approved programs: 21

1 "[(a)] (A) Are consistent with the mission statement of the university;

2 "[(b)] (B) Do not unnecessarily duplicate academic programs offered by
3 Oregon's other public universities;

4 "[(c)] (C) Are not located in a geographic area that will cause undue 5 hardship to Oregon's other public universities; and

6 "[(d)] (**D**) Are allocated among Oregon's public universities to maximize 7 the achievement of statewide needs and requirements.

"(b) The commission may, by rule, develop a process for determining whether an academic program meets the requirements set forth
in paragraph (a)(A) to (D) of this subsection.

"(3)(a) Pursuant to ORS 350.090, on or before September 1 of each evennumbered year, the Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall submit a consolidated funding request to the Governor on behalf of all public universities listed in ORS 352.002.

15 "(b) The Governor's budget may include funding requests from public 16 universities.

"(4) As part of a funding request submitted under subsection (3) of this 17 section, a public university listed in ORS 352.002 may request, and appro-18 priations may include but are not limited to, funding for education and 19 general operations, statewide public services, state-funded debt service, cap-20ital improvements, deferred maintenance, special initiatives and investments 21or any other purpose authorized by ORS 350.075 (3)(e). Any moneys appro-22priated to pay debt service for state bonds must be held by the State Treas-23urer pursuant to an agreement entered into by the State Treasurer and a 24public university under ORS 352.135 (2). 25

"(5) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 that wishes to request the issuance of state bonds, including a public university that elects to remain eligible to receive proceeds of state bonds under ORS 352.402, must make a request to this effect to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission. The commission shall establish a process for reviewing the request to issue state bonds. The commission shall decide whether, and in what manner, to make
a request for the issuance of state bonds to the Legislative Assembly.

"(6)(a) Each public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall respond to a request for data from the Legislative Assembly or other state body by submitting the requested information to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission. The commission shall consolidate the data received from public universities. The commission shall be responsible for providing the data to the Legislative Assembly or other requesting entity.

9 "(b) As used in this subsection, 'data' means any information that, as of 10 August 14, 2013, is collected by the Higher Education Coordinating Com-11 mission from each university and reported to the Legislative Assembly or 12 any other state entity, including but not limited to retention and graduation 13 rates and demographic information on students.

14 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 352.089 by section 1 of this 15 2019 Act apply to significant changes in an academic program for 16 which a public university listed in ORS 352.002 begins preliminary 17 planning on or after the effective date of this 2019 Act.".

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
