## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2303

On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, after "pseudoephedrine;" delete the rest of the line and delete line 3 and insert "and prescribing an effective date.".

4 Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:

5 "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part
6 of ORS chapter 689.

"<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) A pharmacist may prescribe and dispense
pseudoephedrine to a person who is 18 years of age or older and who
provides to the pharmacist the person's valid government-issued photo
identification.

"(2) Prior to prescribing and dispensing pseudoephedrine under this
 section, a pharmacist shall query the prescription monitoring program
 established under ORS 431A.855 to ensure compliance with subsection
 (3) of this section.

15 **"(3) A person may not receive more than nine grams of** 16 **pseudoephedrine in a 30-day period under this section.** 

"(4) The State Board of Pharmacy may adopt rules to carry out this
 section.

"SECTION 3. (1) Section 2 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on
 January 1, 2020.

21 "(2) The State Board of Pharmacy may take any action before the

operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the board to exercise, on and after the operative date
specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions
and powers conferred on the board by section 2 of this 2019 Act.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative
Assembly adjourns sine die.".

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
