PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3270

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "homes" insert a period and delete the rest of the line.

3 Delete lines 4 through 23 and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 443.705 (1), the Department 4 of Human Services shall administer a pilot program to test the oper- $\mathbf{5}$ ation of adult foster homes that provide care to seven adults. The de-6 partment shall prescribe by rule requirements, in addition to existing 7 requirements under ORS 443.705 to 443.825, for adult foster homes that 8 participate in the pilot program. The additional requirements must 9 ensure that a resident's agreement to give up a single occupancy room 10 and share a room with another resident is voluntary and must require 11 12 that a resident sign a residency agreement attesting that the resident's agreement is voluntary. 13

"(2) In approving an adult foster home for the pilot program, the
department must take into account:

"(a) The adult foster home's compliance with regulatory require ments during the preceding two-year period.

"(b) The history of abuse complaints and the findings of investi gators in response to complaints of abuse.

"(c) Input from the local regulatory authority about the adult foster
home's overall ability to take on an additional resident.

"(3) The department shall track and compile data on the success 1 of the pilot program and on the frequency of monitoring of the adult $\mathbf{2}$ foster homes by the local regulatory authorities. The data must in-3 clude, but is not limited to, monitoring increases or decreases in: 4 "(a) The number of complaints; $\mathbf{5}$ "(b) The number of violations of licensing requirements; 6 "(c) The number of substantiated complaints of abuse; and 7 "(d) Resident satisfaction, as measured by resident surveys. 8 "SECTION 2. No later than September 15, 2022, the Department of 9 Human Services shall report to the interim committees of the Legis-10 lative Assembly related to health, in the manner provided in ORS 11 192.245, on the results of the pilot program described in section 1 of 12this 2019 Act and the data tracked and compiled under section 1 (3) of 13 this 2019 Act. 14 "SECTION 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2019 Act are repealed on Jan-15

16 uary 2, 2024.".

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
