

Requested by Senator COURTNEY

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 221**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “needs” insert “; and declaring an  
2 emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 7 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-  
5 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the  
6 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount  
7 of \$6,600,000, which may be expended for intensive in-home services for  
8 children with behavioral health needs.**

9 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-  
10 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the  
11 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount  
12 of \$3,076,000, which may be expended to support statewide implemen-  
13 tation of crisis and transition services.**

14 **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-  
15 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for  
16 the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the  
17 amount of \$6,600,000, which may be expended to support implementa-  
18 tion of the federal Family First Prevention Services Act, 132 Stat. 232  
19 (2018), including the funding of in-home services.**

20 **“SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-  
21 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for**

1 the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the  
2 amount of \$3,500,000, which may be expended for therapeutic foster  
3 care.

4 **“SECTION 5.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-  
5 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for  
6 the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the  
7 amount of \$8,400,000, which may be expended to supplement existing  
8 programs to include enhanced services for children with intellectual  
9 or developmental disabilities who may also have behavioral health  
10 needs.

11 **“SECTION 6.** This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate  
12 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is  
13 declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on July 1, 2019.”.
