PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 221

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "needs" insert "; and declaring an emergency".

3 Delete lines 4 through 7 and insert:

"<u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the
biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount
of \$6,600,000, which may be expended for intensive in-home services for
children with behavioral health needs.

9 "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-10 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the 11 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount 12 of \$3,076,000, which may be expended to support statewide implemen-13 tation of crisis and transition services.

"SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,600,000, which may be expended to support implementation of the federal Family First Prevention Services Act, 132 Stat. 232 (2018), including the funding of in-home services.

20 "<u>SECTION 4.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-21 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the
amount of \$3,500,000, which may be expended for therapeutic foster
care.

4 "<u>SECTION 5.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-5 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for 6 the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the 7 amount of \$8,400,000, which may be expended to supplement existing 8 programs to include enhanced services for children with intellectual 9 or developmental disabilities who may also have behavioral health 10 needs.

"SECTION 6. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on July 1, 2019.".
