PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 452

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, delete "prescribing an effective 2 date" and insert "declaring an emergency".

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

"<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall study the responses of emergency medical services to rare medical conditions,
particularly those conditions requiring emergency use medications for
treatment. The authority shall:

8 "(a) Estimate the frequency, nature and outcomes of emergency
9 responses involving individuals with rare medical conditions;

"(b) Review options for improving emergency responses for indi viduals with rare medical conditions, including the costs, benefits and
 impacts of each option; and

13 "(c) Consult with stakeholders, including but not limited to:

14 "(A) Emergency medical responders;

"(B) Physicians who have experience with this state's emergency
 medical response system;

"(C) Physicians experienced in treating rare medical conditions that
 may require atypical medical treatment during emergency responses,
 particularly those conditions that require emergency use medications;
 and

21 "(D) Individuals who have rare medical conditions.

"(2) The authority shall submit findings and recommendations for
legislation to a committee of the Legislative Assembly related to
health care not later than February 1, 2020.

4 "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2,
5 2021.

6 "SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate 7 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is 8 declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.".
