

Requested by SENATE COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 452**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “prescribing an effective  
2 date” and insert “declaring an emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall study the re-  
5 sponses of emergency medical services to rare medical conditions,  
6 particularly those conditions requiring emergency use medications for  
7 treatment. The authority shall:**

8 **“(a) Estimate the frequency, nature and outcomes of emergency  
9 responses involving individuals with rare medical conditions;**

10 **“(b) Review options for improving emergency responses for indi-  
11 viduals with rare medical conditions, including the costs, benefits and  
12 impacts of each option; and**

13 **“(c) Consult with stakeholders, including but not limited to:**

14 **“(A) Emergency medical responders;**

15 **“(B) Physicians who have experience with this state’s emergency  
16 medical response system;**

17 **“(C) Physicians experienced in treating rare medical conditions that  
18 may require atypical medical treatment during emergency responses,  
19 particularly those conditions that require emergency use medications;  
20 and**

21 **“(D) Individuals who have rare medical conditions.**

1       **“(2) The authority shall submit findings and recommendations for**  
2 **legislation to a committee of the Legislative Assembly related to**  
3 **health care not later than February 1, 2020.**

4       **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2,**  
5 **2021.**

6       **“SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
7 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
8 **declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
