**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 967**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 13, insert:

2 “(5) For the purposes of determining the defendant’s age at the time of  
3 committing an offense under subsection (2) of this section:

4 “(a) If the defendant is convicted of two or more offenses occurring on  
5 different days, the defendant’s age shall be calculated using the earliest date.

6 “(b) If the defendant is convicted of an offense occurring within a range  
7 of dates, the defendant’s age shall be calculated using the date at the be-  
8 ginning of the range.”.

9 On page 4, after line 23, insert:

10 “(10) For the purposes of determining the person’s age at the time of  
11 committing an offense under this section:

12 “(a) If the person is convicted of two or more offenses occurring on dif-  
13 ferent days, the person’s age shall be calculated using the earliest date.

14 “(b) If the person is convicted of an offense occurring within a range of  
15 dates, the person’s age shall be calculated using the date at the beginning  
16 of the range.”.

17 On page 5, after line 27, insert:

18 “(5) For the purposes of determining the person’s age at the time of  
19 committing an offense under this section:

20 “(a) If the person is convicted of two or more offenses occurring on dif-  
21 ferent days, the person’s age shall be calculated using the earliest date.
