**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 730**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages
2 2 and 3 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 350.395 is amended to read:

4 “350.395. (1) As used in this section:

5 “(a) ‘Associate transfer degree’ means an associate degree that is awarded
6 by a community college and that is intended to allow a student to apply the
7 credits earned for the degree toward a baccalaureate degree.

8 “(b) ‘Community college’ means a community college operated under ORS
9 chapter 341.

10 **“(c) ‘Foundational curriculum’ means a curriculum established un-
11 der ORS 350.400.**

12 “[~~(c)~~] (d) ‘Public university’ means a public university listed in ORS
13 352.002.

14 “[~~(d)~~] (e) ‘Transfer program’ means a one-year program that is designed
15 to allow a student to apply the credits earned through the program toward
16 a baccalaureate degree.

17 **“(f) ‘Unified statewide transfer agreement’ means an agreement
18 established under ORS 350.404.**

19 “(2) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall develop stan-
20 dards related to the ability of students to apply credits earned through
21 courses of study at community colleges to baccalaureate degrees awarded by

1 public universities. The standards shall be known as the ‘Transfer Student
2 Bill of Rights and Responsibilities.’ **In developing these standards, com-
3 mission staff shall consult with the advisory committee established in
4 section 2 of this 2019 Act.**

5 “(3) The standards developed under this section must include:

6 “(a) Admission standards to public universities for students who have
7 earned an associate transfer degree **or who have attained the optimal
8 number of academic credits identified in a unified statewide transfer
9 agreement.**

10 “(b) Processes to align requirements for community college courses and
11 public university courses to ensure that credits earned for completion of
12 sufficiently similar courses are fully transferable between all community
13 colleges and public universities.

14 “(c) Processes to minimize the number of credits that students who have
15 **either** earned an associate transfer degree **or who have completed all
16 coursework in a transfer program, foundational curriculum or unified
17 statewide transfer agreement** would need to complete prior to receiving
18 various types of baccalaureate degrees at public universities[, *including
19 identifying majors in baccalaureate degree programs that require more than
20 two years to complete after a student has earned an associate transfer
21 degree*].

22 “[*(d) Processes to minimize the number of credits that students who have
23 completed a transfer program would need to complete prior to receiving various
24 types of baccalaureate degrees at public universities.*]

25 “**(d) Methods for minimizing the complexity of unified statewide
26 transfer agreements.**

27 “**(e) Processes requiring:**

28 “**(A) The chief academic officer of a community college or public
29 university requesting a variance to an established unified statewide
30 transfer agreement to, at the request of the advisory committee es-**

1 **tablished in section 2 of this 2019 Act, provide information to the**
2 **committee on the pedagogical requirements supporting the position**
3 **of the community college or public university; and**

4 **“(B) The chief academic officers of community colleges or public**
5 **universities who disagree over the inclusion or exclusion of courses in**
6 **a unified statewide transfer agreement to, at the request of the advi-**
7 **sory committee established in section 2 of this 2019 Act, provide in-**
8 **formation to the committee on the pedagogical requirements**
9 **supporting the positions of the community colleges or public univer-**
10 **sities.**

11 “[*e*] **(f)** Processes by which a community college would award an asso-
12 ciate degree to a student upon completion of necessary credits, regardless
13 of whether the student applied to receive the degree or whether the student
14 earned the credits for the degree at a community college or a public uni-
15 versity.

16 “[*f*] **(g)** Processes to evaluate and make recommendations for the devel-
17 opment of associate transfer degrees **or unified statewide transfer agree-**
18 **ments** in specific areas of study[, *including engineering*].

19 “[*g*] **(h)** Any other issues identified by the Higher Education Coordi-
20 nating Commission that relate to courses of study at community colleges and
21 the ability of a student to transfer credits to a community college or a public
22 university, to be admitted to a public university or to earn a degree at a
23 community college or a public university.

24 “[*h*] **(i)** Requirements that students must meet in order to benefit from
25 the standards described in paragraphs (a) to [*g*] **(h)** of this subsection.

26 **“(4) [*Each community college and public university shall submit annual***
27 ***reports to*] The Higher Education Coordinating Commission [*related to*] **shall**
28 **annually submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 to the**
29 **appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly setting**
30 **forth:****

1 “(a) The number of students who attend a community college and then a
2 public university[, or a public university and then a community college].

3 “(b) The number of students who attend one community college and then
4 a different community college.

5 “(c) The number of students who transfer from a community college to a
6 public university and who have an associate transfer degree or have com-
7 pleted a transfer program.

8 “(d) The average number of credits students have when they transfer from
9 a community college to a public university **and the average number of**
10 **credits accepted by the public university.**

11 “(e) The average number of credits students have when they attend one
12 community college and then a different community college.

13 “(f) The average number of credits that a student earning an associate
14 transfer degree completed at a community college.

15 “(g) The average number of credits students who have transferred from
16 a community college to a public university must earn prior to receiving a
17 baccalaureate degree compared to the average number of credits students
18 who did not transfer from a community college must earn prior to receiving
19 a baccalaureate degree.

20 “(h)(A) **The number and nature of the requests submitted under**
21 **subsection (3)(e) of this section to the advisory committee established**
22 **in section 2 of this 2019 Act; and**

23 “(B) **The determination reached by the committee for each request**
24 **described in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph.**

25 “**SECTION 2. The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall**
26 **establish an advisory committee consisting of faculty, staff and ad-**
27 **ministration representatives from community colleges and public uni-**
28 **versities listed in ORS 352.002, and any other parties the commission**
29 **deems necessary. The advisory committee shall provide advice and**
30 **recommendations to commission staff on:**

1 **“(1) Designing standards to effectively implement ORS 350.395; and**
2 **“(2) Developing an electronic system for the dissemination of in-**
3 **formation regarding foundational curricula established under ORS**
4 **350.400 and unified statewide transfer agreements established under**
5 **ORS 350.404.**

6 **“SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate**
7 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
8 **declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
