**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2735**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “declaring an emergency” and
2 insert “prescribing an effective date”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Disaster Response and Recovery**
5 **is established.**

6 **“(2) The task force consists of 35 members appointed as follows:**

7 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint two members from**
8 **among members of the Senate, one of whom must be the chair of the**
9 **Senate Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness.**

10 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two**
11 **members from among members of the House of Representatives, one**
12 **of whom must be the chair of the House Committee on Veterans and**
13 **Emergency Preparedness.**

14 **“(c) The Governor shall appoint as members one representative**
15 **from each of:**

16 **“(A) The Oregon Military Department;**

17 **“(B) The Office of Emergency Management;**

18 **“(C) The Department of Corrections;**

19 **“(D) The Department of Environmental Quality;**

20 **“(E) The Department of Human Services;**

21 **“(F) The Department of Justice;**

1 **“(G) The Department of Land Conservation and Development;**
2 **“(H) The Department of State Police;**
3 **“(I) The Department of Transportation;**
4 **“(J) The office of the State Resilience Officer;**
5 **“(K) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services;**
6 **“(L) The Oregon Department of Aviation;**
7 **“(M) The Oregon Health Authority;**
8 **“(N) The Public Utility Commission of Oregon;**
9 **“(O) The State Department of Agriculture;**
10 **“(P) The State Department of Energy;**
11 **“(Q) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife;**
12 **“(R) The State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries;**
13 **“(S) The office of the State Fire Marshal;**
14 **“(T) The State Forestry Department;**
15 **“(U) The State Marine Board;**
16 **“(V) The State Parks and Recreation Department;**
17 **“(W) The office of the State Treasurer;**
18 **“(X) The Travel Information Council; and**
19 **“(Y) The Water Resources Department.**
20 **“(d) The Governor shall appoint five members as follows:**
21 **“(A) One member representing counties in this state;**
22 **“(B) One member representing cities in this state;**
23 **“(C) One member representing special districts in this state;**
24 **“(D) One member representing the American Red Cross or a similar**
25 **organization; and**
26 **“(E) One member of the public who has experience or interest in**
27 **disaster response and recovery.**
28 **“(e) The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court shall appoint one**
29 **member representing the Judicial Department.**
30 **“(3) The task force shall:**

1 **“(a) Identify locations that are suitable or may be made suitable for**
2 **emergency preparedness, response and recovery needs, including:**

3 **“(A) Rally points or gathering points for individuals displaced in an**
4 **emergency;**

5 **“(B) Spaces for staging emergency response equipment or person-**
6 **nel; and**

7 **“(C) Recovery spaces for medium-term care, housing and support**
8 **for individuals during an emergency;**

9 **“(b) Identify projects that are necessary or advisable to prepare**
10 **spaces identified under paragraph (a) of this subsection for use for**
11 **emergency purposes;**

12 **“(c) Identify projects that are necessary or advisable to prepare**
13 **Redmond Municipal Airport and the Oregon International Port of Coos**
14 **Bay for use as primary transportation points in an emergency, in-**
15 **cluding use for:**

16 **“(A) Receiving assistance from the federal government or other**
17 **state governments; and**

18 **“(B) Transporting personnel and equipment within and without this**
19 **state;**

20 **“(d) Identify other projects that are necessary or advisable to in-**
21 **crease the emergency resilience of this state; and**

22 **“(e) Assign priorities to and determine funding requirements for**
23 **projects identified under paragraphs (b), (c) and (d) of this subsection.**

24 **“(4) The task force may, in carrying out its duties, consult with any**
25 **advisors or other persons as the task force deems necessary or advis-**
26 **able.**

27 **“(5) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a**
28 **quorum for the transaction of business.**

29 **“(6) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**
30 **majority of the members of the task force.**

1 **“(7) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as**
2 **chairperson.**

3 **“(8) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority**
4 **shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.**

5 **“(9) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the**
6 **call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the task**
7 **force.**

8 **“(10) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation**
9 **of the task force.**

10 **“(11) The task force shall submit a report on its findings, which**
11 **may include recommendations for legislation, to the Legislative As-**
12 **sembly in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 no later than September**
13 **15, 2020.**

14 **“(12) The Office of Emergency Management shall provide staff sup-**
15 **port to the task force.**

16 **“(13) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-**
17 **islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement**
18 **for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.**

19 **“(14) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,**
20 **are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the task**
21 **force’s duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to**
22 **confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the**
23 **task force consider necessary to perform their duties.**

24 **“(15) As used in this section:**

25 **“(a) ‘Emergency’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 401.025.**

26 **“(b) ‘Project’ includes, without limitation, infrastructure upgrades,**
27 **construction or acquisition of real property, acquisition of equipment**
28 **or other personal property, hiring, training or assignment of personnel**
29 **and organizational or budgetary modifications.**

30 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on December 31,**

1 2020.

2 “SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
3 date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative
4 Assembly adjourns sine die.”

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
