PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 827

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "ORS" insert "471.001 and".

2 Delete lines 4 through 14 and insert:

³ **"SECTION 1.** ORS 471.001 is amended to read:

4 "471.001. As used in this chapter and ORS chapter 473:

5 "(1) 'Alcoholic beverage' and 'alcoholic liquor' mean any liquid or solid 6 containing more than one-half of one percent alcohol by volume and capable 7 of being consumed by a human being.

8 "(2) 'Commercial establishment' means a place of business:

9 "(a) Where food is cooked and served;

"(b) That has kitchen facilities adequate for the preparation and servingof meals;

"(c) That has dining facilities adequate for the serving and consumptionof meals; and

14 "(d) That:

"(A) If not a for-profit private club, serves meals to the general public;
 or

"(B) If a for-profit private club, serves meals to the club's members and
 guests and complies with any minimum membership and food service re quirements established by Oregon Liquor Control Commission rules.

20 "(3) 'Commission' means the Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

"(4) 'Distilled liquor' means any alcoholic beverage other than a wine,

1 cider or malt beverage. 'Distilled liquor' includes distilled spirits.

2 "(5) 'Licensee' means any person holding a license issued under this 3 chapter.

"(6)(a) 'Malt beverage' means an alcoholic beverage obtained by the
fermentation of grain that contains not more than 14 percent alcohol by
volume.

7 "(b) 'Malt beverage' includes:

8 "(A) Beer, ale, porter, stout and similar alcoholic beverages containing
9 not more than 14 percent alcohol by volume;

"(B) Malt beverages containing six percent or less alcohol by volume and that contain at least 51 percent alcohol by volume obtained by the fermentation of grain, as long as not more than 49 percent of the beverage's overall alcohol content is obtained from flavors and other added nonbeverage ingredients containing alcohol; and

"(C) Malt beverages containing more than six percent alcohol by volume that derive not more than 1.5 percent of the beverage's overall alcohol content by volume from flavors and other added nonbeverage ingredients containing alcohol.

"(c) 'Malt beverage' does not include cider or an alcoholic beverage obtained primarily by fermentation of rice, such as sake.

"(7) 'Manufacturer' means every person who produces, brews, ferments, manufactures or blends an alcoholic beverage within this state or who imports or causes to be imported into this state an alcoholic beverage for sale or distribution within the state.

"(8) 'Permittee' means a person holding a permit issued under ORS 471.360
to 471.385.

²⁷ "[(9) 'Premises' or 'licensed premises' means a location licensed under this ²⁸ chapter and includes all enclosed areas at the location that are used in the ²⁹ business operated at the location, including offices, kitchens, rest rooms and ³⁰ storerooms, including all public and private areas where patrons are permitted to be present. 'Premises' or 'licensed premises' includes areas outside of a
building that the commission has specifically designated as approved for alcoholic beverage service or consumption.]

"(9) 'Premises' or 'licensed premises' means a place described under
paragraph (a), (b) or (c) of this subsection as determined and approved
by the commission:

7 "(a)(A) A location licensed under this chapter;

"(B) Offices, kitchens, rest rooms, storerooms or other enclosed
areas used in the business operating a location licensed under this
chapter;

11 "(C) All enclosed public and private areas of a location licensed 12 under this chapter where patrons are permitted to be present; and

"(D) Areas outside of a building licensed as provided under this
 paragraph, if the commission has specifically designated or approved
 the area for alcoholic beverage service or consumption.

"(b)(A) A mobile dispensary equipped for selling malt beverages,
 wine or cider that is not a public passenger carrier described in ORS
 471.182; and

"(B) An area adjacent to a mobile dispensary described in paragraph
(b) of this subsection that meets any applicable criteria specified by
the commission for the consumption of malt beverages, wine or cider
sold from a mobile dispensary.

²³ "(c) A public passenger carrier described in ORS 471.182.

"(10) 'Regulatory specialist' means a full-time employee of the commission who is authorized to act as an agent of the commission in conducting inspections or investigations, making arrests and seizures, aiding in prosecutions for offenses, issuing citations for violations and otherwise enforcing this chapter, ORS 474.005 to 474.095, 474.115, 475B.010 to 475B.545, 475B.550 to 475B.590 and 475B.600 to 475B.655, commission rules and any other statutes the commission considers related to regulating liquor, marijuana or

"(11) 'Wine' means any fermented vinous liquor or fruit juice, or other fermented beverage fit for beverage purposes that is not a malt beverage, containing more than one-half of one percent of alcohol by volume and not more than 21 percent of alcohol by volume. 'Wine' includes fortified wine. 'Wine' does not include cider.

"SECTION 2. ORS 471.159 is amended to read:

"471.159. (1) [The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may not license a 8 location that does not have defined boundaries.] If the Oregon Liquor Con-9 trol Commission licenses a location as a premises under ORS 471.001 10 (9)(a), the location must have fixed boundaries. If the commission li-11 censes a mobile premises that is not a public passenger carrier de-12 scribed in ORS 471.182, each location at which the mobile premises 13 sells malt beverages, wine or cider must conform to any applicable 14 criteria specified by the commission for the sale of malt beverages, 15 wine or cider by a mobile dispensary or for the consumption of malt 16 beverages, wine or cider in an area adjacent to a mobile dispensary. 17

"(2) A licensed premises need not be enclosed by a wall, fence or other structure, but the commission may require that any licensed premises be enclosed as a condition of issuing or renewing a license.

"(3) Except as provided in ORS 471.182, [the commission may not license premises that are mobile] a mobile premises must be licensed only for limited on-premises sales or must be a location where a brewery-public house licensee conducts activities under ORS 471.200 (1)(g). This subsection does not authorize a brewery-public house licensee to conduct activities on a public passenger carrier described in ORS 471.182.".
