An owner or 6 operator that posts the cost per gallon of the low carbon fuel standard shall 7 also post the calculation of the concurrent total greenhouse gas emissions re-8 ductions attributable to the low carbon fuel standard. The owner or operator 9 may make the disclosures provided for in this subsection by:] 10

11 "[(a) Posting the disclosures on a gasoline pump in a manner that is visible 12 to customers;]

"[(b) Printing the disclosures on a receipt that the owner or operator pro vides to a customer; or]
