

Requested by Senator GELSER

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 221**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “needs” insert “; and declaring an  
2 emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 7 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-  
5 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the  
6 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount  
7 of \$6,600,000, which may be expended for intensive in-home services for  
8 children with behavioral health needs.**

9 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-  
10 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the  
11 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount  
12 of \$3,076,000, which may be expended to support statewide implemen-  
13 tation of crisis and transition services.**

14 **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-  
15 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for  
16 the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the  
17 amount of \$6,600,000, which may be expended beginning July 1, 2020,  
18 to support implementation of the federal Family First Prevention  
19 Services Act, 132 Stat. 232 (2018), by funding evidence-based prevention  
20 services that are flexible enough to support families in their homes,  
21 schools and communities.**

1       **“SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**  
2 **ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for**  
3 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the**  
4 **amount of \$3,500,000, which may be expended for therapeutic foster**  
5 **care.**

6       **“SECTION 5. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appro-**  
7 **priation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services,**  
8 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the**  
9 **amount of \$8,400,000, which may be expended to supplement existing**  
10 **programs to include enhanced services for children with intellectual**  
11 **or developmental disabilities, including but not limited to children**  
12 **with intellectual or developmental disabilities who may also have be-**  
13 **havioral health needs.**

14       **“(2) The department shall prioritize expenditures described in sub-**  
15 **section (1) of this section for services that prevent out-of-home care**  
16 **or that are provided in settings that include children with and without**  
17 **intellectual and developmental disabilities.**

18       **“SECTION 6. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
19 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
20 **declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on July 1, 2019.”.**
