**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 318**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete line 3 and insert “107.102.”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete pages 2 through 7 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 107.102 is amended to read:

4 “107.102. (1) In any proceeding to establish or modify a judgment provid-
5 ing for parenting time with a child, except for matters filed under ORS
6 107.700 to 107.735, there shall be developed and filed with the court a par-
7 enting plan to be included in the judgment. A parenting plan may be either
8 general or detailed.

9 “(2) A general parenting plan may include a general outline of how par-
10 ental responsibilities and parenting time will be shared and may allow the
11 parents to develop a more detailed agreement on an informal basis. However,
12 a general parenting plan must set forth the minimum amount of parenting
13 time and access a noncustodial parent is entitled to have.

14 “(3) A detailed parenting plan may include, but need not be limited to,
15 provisions relating to:

16 “(a) Residential schedule;

17 “(b) Holiday, birthday and vacation planning;

18 “(c) Weekends, including holidays, and school in-service days preceding
19 or following weekends;

20 “(d) Decision-making and responsibility;

21 “(e) Information sharing and access;

1 “(f) Relocation of parents;

2 “(g) Telephone access;

3 “(h) Transportation; and

4 “(i) Methods for resolving disputes.

5 “(4)(a) The court shall develop a detailed parenting plan when:

6 “(A) So requested by either parent; or

7 “(B) The parent or parents are unable to develop a parenting plan.

8 “(b) In developing a parenting plan under this subsection, the court may
9 consider only the best interests of the child and the safety of the parties.

10 **“(c) In developing a parenting plan under this subsection, the court**
11 **may order equal parenting time. If a parent requests that the court**
12 **order equal parenting time in the parenting plan, the court may deny**
13 **the request if the court determines, by written findings, that equal**
14 **parenting time is not in the best interests of the child or endangers**
15 **the safety of the parties.**

16 **“SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 107.102 by section 1 of this**
17 **2019 Act apply to proceedings commenced on or after the effective date**
18 **of this 2019 Act.”.**
