**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 852**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “and”.

2 In line 3, after “350.355” insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 24 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 350.355 is amended to read:

5 “350.355. (1) [*Subject to ORS 352.237 and any group health and welfare*
6 *insurance benefit plan developed under ORS 352.237,*] A part-time faculty
7 member at a public institution of higher education is eligible for [*the same*]
8 health care benefits as [*full-time faculty members*] **provided in this section**
9 if the part-time faculty member is eligible for membership in the Public
10 Employees Retirement System or another plan authorized under ORS chapter
11 238 or 238A by teaching either at a single public institution of higher edu-
12 cation or in aggregate at multiple public institutions of higher education
13 during the prior year.

14 **“(2)(a) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section,** a part-
15 time faculty member at a public institution of higher education shall pay:
16 [*all insurance premiums for health care benefits unless otherwise provided for*
17 *by the policy of the institution or by collective bargaining at the institution.*]

18 **“(A) For employee-only coverage, 10 percent of the insurance pre-**
19 **miums for health benefit plans.**

20 **“(B) For employee and dependent coverage, 10 percent of the in-**
21 **surance premiums for health benefit plans the employee would have**

1 paid for employee-only coverage plus 50 percent of the difference in the
2 cost of insurance premiums for employee-only coverage and employee
3 and dependent coverage.

4 “(b) The state shall pay, out of funds appropriated to the Oregon
5 Educators Benefit Board by the Legislative Assembly, for the cost of
6 the insurance premiums for health benefit plans described in para-
7 graph (a) of this subsection that are not paid by a part-time faculty
8 member.

9 “(3) A public institution of higher education may agree through
10 collective bargaining to pay some or all of the premiums a part-time
11 faculty member is required to pay under subsection (2)(a) of this sec-
12 tion.

13 “(4)(a) Prior to each annual open enrollment period during which
14 part-time faculty members may select health benefit plans, the board
15 shall determine whether the board has received sufficient appropri-
16 ations to make the payments described in subsection (2)(b) of this
17 section.

18 “(b) If the board determines that it has not received sufficient ap-
19 propriations:

20 “(A) A public institution of higher education is not required to
21 provide moneys for the cost of the insurance premiums for health
22 benefit plans described in subsection (2)(b) of this section; and

23 “(B) The board may, to the extent the board determines is neces-
24 sary, increase the percentages specified in subsection (2)(a) of this
25 section that a part-time faculty member is required to pay to receive
26 a health benefit plan.

27 “(5) A part-time faculty member at a public institution of higher
28 education who is eligible for health care benefits under subsection (1)
29 of this section may receive health care benefits only in the manner
30 provided by this section.

1 “(6) The board may make rules to implement this section, including
2 which health benefit plans are offered to part-time faculty members
3 under this section and how the health benefit plans that are offered
4 are selected.

5 “SECTION 2. A public institution of higher education that, on the
6 effective date of this 2019 Act, provided health care benefits to part-
7 time faculty members who are not eligible for health benefit plans
8 under the amendments to ORS 350.355 by section 1 of this 2019 Act:

9 “(1) May not increase the eligibility requirements that must be met
10 by a part-time faculty member who is not eligible for health benefit
11 plans under the amendments to ORS 350.355 by section 1 of this 2019
12 Act in order for the part-time faculty member to qualify for health
13 care benefits from the institution; and

14 “(2) Must continue to provide comparable health care benefits to
15 part-time faculty members who are not eligible for health benefit plans
16 under the amendments to ORS 350.355 by section 1 of this 2019 Act.

17 “SECTION 3. Any realized savings by a public institution of higher
18 education as a result of the amendments to ORS 350.355 by section 1
19 of this 2019 Act are considered employment relations for purposes of
20 collective bargaining under ORS 243.650 to 243.782.

21 “SECTION 4. The Part-Time Faculty Insurance Fund is established
22 in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund.
23 Interest earned by the Part-Time Faculty Insurance Fund must be
24 credited to the fund. The fund consists of moneys appropriated, allo-
25 cated, deposited or transferred to the fund by the Legislative Assembly
26 or otherwise and interest earned on moneys in the fund. The moneys
27 in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Oregon Educators
28 Benefit Board for the purpose of paying premiums for health benefit
29 plans for part-time faculty under ORS 350.355.

30 “SECTION 5. There is appropriated to the Oregon Educators Benefit

1 Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General
2 Fund, the amount of \$_____ for deposit in the Part-Time Faculty In-
3 surance Fund established in section 4 of this 2019 Act, for the purposes
4 specified in section 4 of this 2019 Act.

5 **“SECTION 6. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,**
6 **the amendments to ORS 350.355 by section 1 of this 2019 Act apply to**
7 **health benefit plans offered to part-time faculty members on or after**
8 **October 1, 2020.**

9 **“(2) To the extent that a conflict exists, the terms of collective**
10 **bargaining agreements and other contracts entered into before the**
11 **effective date of this 2019 Act shall prevail over the amendments to**
12 **ORS 350.355 by section 1 of this 2019 Act.**

13 **“SECTION 7. The Oregon Educators Benefit Board shall, before the**
14 **applicability date specified in section 6 of this 2019 Act, take any**
15 **actions necessary to implement the amendments to ORS 350.355 by**
16 **section 1 of this 2019 Act on the applicability date specified in section**
17 **6 of this 2019 Act.**

18 **“SECTION 8. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate**
19 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
20 **declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
