## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 591

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "wine" insert "; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 471.442".

3 Delete lines 4 through 9 and insert:

4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 471.442 is amended to read:

5 "471.442. (1)(a) No wine or cider [*shall*] **may** be sold or offered for sale 6 within this state unless [*it*] **the wine or cider** complies with the minimum 7 standards fixed pursuant to law.

"(b) No wine may be sold or offered for sale within this state if the
wine is deceptively labeled or branded as to content or geographic origin.

"(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may require a manufacturer, importer or wholesaler to provide samples of a particular wine or cider, and to provide a laboratory analysis demonstrating to the satisfaction of the commission that the particular wine or cider complies with the minimum standards in this state.

"(3) No wine or cider offered for sale within this state may be altered or tampered with in any way by any person not licensed to do so by the commission.

"(4) The commission may prohibit the sale of any wine or cider for a reasonable period of time while it is determining whether the wine or cider complies with minimum standards in this state. "SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part
 of ORS chapter 471.

"SECTION 3. A person engages in an unlawful practice in violation
of ORS 646.608 if the person violates:

5 "(1) ORS 471.442 (1) or 471.446 (2) with regard to wine;

6 "(2) Any minimum standards for wine established by rule; or

"(3) Any branding or labeling requirements for wine established by
rule.".
