PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 46

On page 1 of the printed bill, line 7, delete the colon and insert ", within a 12-month period, results in the extraction of between 500 and 5,000 cubic yards of minerals.".

4 Delete lines 8 through 13 and insert:

5 "(2) Mining conducted under a valid exclusion certificate may expand the 6 affected area by not more than one acre of land within any 12-month period 7 unless the total acreage of surface disturbance by the mining operation ex-8 ceeds five acres.".

9 In line 14, delete "(2)" and insert "(3)".

10 In line 17, delete "(3)" and insert "(4)".

In line 21, delete "(4)" and insert "(5)".

12 On page 4, delete lines 4 through 7 and insert:

13 "(H) Excavation or grading operations that:

"(i) Are necessary for on-site construction activities that do not require
a local government land use decision or are expressly authorized under state
law; and

"(ii) Do not result in any excavated minerals being sold into the commercial market as aggregate material.".
