PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2441

Delete lines 5 through 31 of the printed bill and insert:

"SECTION 2. (1) Each school district must provide a coordinated comprehensive school counseling program to support the academic, career, personal and social development of each student and to develop the sense of community involvement for each student.

- "(2)(a) Except as provided by paragraph (b) of this subsection, a coordinated comprehensive school counseling program must be implemented by a person who is licensed by the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission as a school counselor.
- "(b) A coordinated comprehensive school counseling program may be implemented by a person who is licensed by the commission as a school social worker, or by any combination of persons licensed by the commission who are competent to implement the program, if:
- "(A) The person or combination of persons implement the program only for students in grade eight or below; or
- "(B) The school district is unable to employ a licensed school counselor after making reasonable efforts to employ a licensed school counselor because of lack of availability of licensed school counselors in the area served by the school district.
- 20 "(3) The State Board of Education shall adopt by rule standards for 21 coordinated comprehensive school counseling programs. When adopt-

ing rules, the board shall:

- "(a) Collaborate with the commission to ensure that the standards are as inclusive as possible for the purpose of determining who can implement a coordinated comprehensive school counseling program while ensuring that the purposes and quality of the program are maintained.
- "(b) Provide flexibility in who can implement a coordinated comprehensive school counseling program, in recognition of resources that may be limited in some school districts.
- "(c) Annually review the standards to ensure that any necessary adjustments are made in a timely manner to increase the inclusivity of qualified persons who may implement a coordinated comprehensive school counseling program.
- "(4) For the purpose of increasing the inclusivity of qualified persons who may implement a coordinated comprehensive school counseling program, the commission shall coordinate with:
 - "(a) Educator preparation providers; and
- "(b) Providers of other educational programs that would be relevant to a coordinated comprehensive school counseling program implemented under this section.".
