## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3058

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "pesticides" insert "; and declaring an emergency".

3 After line 2, insert:

Whereas the United States Environmental Protection Agency is already
 considering banning pesticide products containing chlorpyrifos; and

6 "Whereas ongoing court proceedings and United States Environmental 7 Protection Agency actions may not result in sufficient protection to human 8 health according to a reasonable timeline; now, therefore,".

9 Delete lines 4 through 22 and insert:

"<u>SECTION 1.</u> The State Department of Agriculture shall review the
 scientific data regarding the safety of current uses within Oregon of
 pesticide products that contain chlorpyrifos. No later than January 1,
 2020, the department shall:

14 "(1) Act to restrict the use of chlorpyrifos in outdoor settings;

15 "(2) Act to commence the phasing out of the sale, purchase or use 16 of chlorpyrifos in outdoor settings except in situations where the de-17 partment determines that there is no available alternative to 18 chlorpyrifos; or

"(3) Report to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly
 relating to natural resources, in the manner provided under ORS
 192.245, regarding the findings by the department and including any

**recommendations of the department for legislative action.** 

<u>"SECTION 2.</u> This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.".
