PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2202

1 Delete lines 4 through 7 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall develop
and administer a program to conduct outreach to residents of Oregon
who served in the Oregon National Guard or a reserve component of
the Armed Forces of the United States to:

6 "(a) Inform them about trade careers; and

7 "(b) Connect them with available apprenticeship opportunities.

8 "(2) The bureau may issue grants to trade unions and trade associ-9 ations to be used to conduct outreach through job fairs or similar 10 recruitment methods.

"(3) The bureau may enter into one or more agreements with other
 state agencies, including the Department of Veterans' Affairs, the
 Employment Department and the Department of Transportation, for
 the purpose of identifying individuals for outreach purposes.

"(4) The bureau shall adopt rules to administer and implement the
 provisions of this section.

"SECTION 2. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1,
2019, from the Veterans' Services Fund established under ORS 406.140,
to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, the amount of \$250,000 for the
purpose of implementing the provisions of section 1 of this 2019 Act.
"SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on Jan-

1 uary 1, 2021.

2 "SECTION 4. The Bureau of Labor and Industries may take any 3 action before the operative date specified in section 3 of this 2019 Act 4 that is necessary for the bureau to exercise, on and after the operative 5 date specified in section 3 of this 2019 Act, all of the duties, functions 6 and powers conferred on the bureau by section 1 of this 2019 Act.".
