## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2550

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 32 and delete page 2 2 and insert:

<sup>3</sup> **"SECTION 1.** ORS 396.150 is amended to read:

"396.150. (1) The Governor shall appoint an Adjutant General, subject 4 to confirmation by the Senate in the manner provided in ORS 171.562  $\mathbf{5}$ and 171.565. The Adjutant General [who] shall hold office for a four-year 6 term or until relieved by reason of resignation, withdrawal of federal recog-7 nition or for cause to be determined by a court-martial. The current term of 8 an Adjutant General continues until its prescribed expiration date while 9 such Adjutant General is serving in a federal active duty status under an 10 order or call by the President of the United States. Voluntary entry onto 11 12 extended active duty by a person holding the office of Adjutant General is an automatic resignation of such officer. 13

"(2) A person is eligible for appointment to the office of Adjutant General 14 if the person is an officer of the Oregon National Guard, federally recognized 15 in the grade of lieutenant colonel or higher, and has completed at least six 16 years' service in the Oregon National Guard as a federally recognized officer. 17 "(3) The Adjutant General may be appointed in the grade of lieutenant 18 colonel or higher, but not exceeding that of lieutenant general. If appointed 19 in a lower grade, the Adjutant General may be promoted by the Governor 20to any grade not exceeding that of lieutenant general.". 21
